Town of Barnstable Marina Descriptions:

Barnstable Harbor: Situated in Barnstable Village, 10 miles east of the Cape Cod Canal. Two local boat ramps, 67 town run recreational, transient and commercial slips, vessels up to 50 feet depending on availability, pumpout station, near local restaurants and main street, water and electrical available. The marina is reached through a long federal and local maintain channel starting at BH buoy. Barnstable Harbor has a ten foot tide cycle and shoaling areas throughout the harbor exist outside of the channel. The area has two local private marinas with fuel docks, mechanics and boat sales. May 1 booking for transient dockage is suggested although not required in the town run marina. VHF09 508-326-1836

Prince Cove Marina: Situated in the Marston Mills village, in the "Three Bays Area". It's small marina but has recreation, transient and commercial slips for vessels up to 36 feet, 43 slips total, water and electrical available. Boat ramp on location, parking available daily for vehicles and trailers upon availability. Winter storage available (work not allowed). Shops and stores in walking distance although sidewalks not available. Best option is by vehicle. Accessible through a local channel well marked from Nantucket Sound (Cotuit Bay or West Bay). Local marinas in the "Three Bays Area" include restaurants, fuel docks, town wharf with launch service etc. VHF09 508-420-3267

Gateway Marina: Situated in the Hyannis village within Hyannis Inner Harbor. 23 slips recreational, commercial and transient for vessels up to 25 feet. Footsteps from Hyannis Main Street. Located directly behind the Maritime Museum. Water and Electrical available. Approach is federally and local maintained. Easy access to Lewis Bay, HyannisPort and Nantucket Sound. Private marina in harbor with fuel dock. VHF09 508-790-6273

Bismore Park Marina: Situated in Hyannis village within Hyannis Inner Harbor. 25 slips available for recreational, commercial and transient usage for vessels up to 75 feet. Walking distance to downtown Hyannis and local shops and restaurants. Located directly next to Hyline ferry terminal. Mainly commercial usage, water and electrical available. Commercial offload zone available for fee. Federal and local channel upon approach from Nantucket Sound. Fueling allowed at offload zone designated times. Also private marina in harbor with fuel dock. VHF09 508-790-6273
